# Testosterone as a Biomarker for Quality of Life (QOL) Following Androgen Deprivation Therapy (ADT) and Stereotactic Body Radiotherapy (SBRT).

## Collaborative Research Studies Explore Prostate & Lung Cancer

In the new study, researchers found for the first time the presence of histone acetylation in prostate cancer cells that enables the process. The discovery may explain why androgen therapy stops working in many after about 1 year, and also why higher cholesterol rates place Black men at greater risk for developing prostate cancer than Asian or white men.

# Radiation Therapy for High-Risk Asymptomatic Bone Metastases Improves Outcomes

Prophylactic radiation therapy delivered to patients with high-risk asymptomatic bone metastases from cancer decreases the risk for skeletal-related events (SREs), hospitalization, and death, according to the findings of a phase 2 clinical trial that investigators believe is the first study of its kind.



The Gleason classification system is most often used to grade prostate cancer. It is used for adenocarcinoma, which is the most common type of prostate cancer.
