**Geoffrey Gotto**

Dr. Gotto is a Urologic Oncologist specializing in the management of prostate, bladder, and kidney cancer. He completed his undergraduate and residency training at the University of British Columbia (UBC) and went on to complete a Fellowship in Urologic Oncology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York and his Masters of Public Health (MPH) at Harvard.

Dr. Gotto is the Medical Director of the Clinic for Advanced and Metastatic Prostate Cancer (CAMP) at the Prostate Cancer Centre and is the Principal Investigator for a number of clinical trials in advanced prostate cancer. He is the Surgical Outcomes Leader for the Southern Alberta Institute of Urology.




## PSMA and Beyond 2025: Beyond PSMA in Prostate Cancer: STEAP1, DLL3, and CD46




## Genomic classifier score linked with focal therapy outcomes in prostate cancer

"Focal therapy of prostate cancer (PCa) is of increasing interest because it may provide cancer cure while preserving quality of life," the authors explained. "However, within 2 years of treatment, up to one third of patients undergoing focal therapy experience disease recurrence."

## CaverSTIM device shows initial promise for post-prostatectomy erectile dysfunction

Overall, use of the device was shown to be safe and feasible, with no device explantations, device-relation infections, nor pain reported during stimulation. Two patients reported mild, transient discomfort. Implantation of the device added approximately 45 minutes to the RARP procedure.
